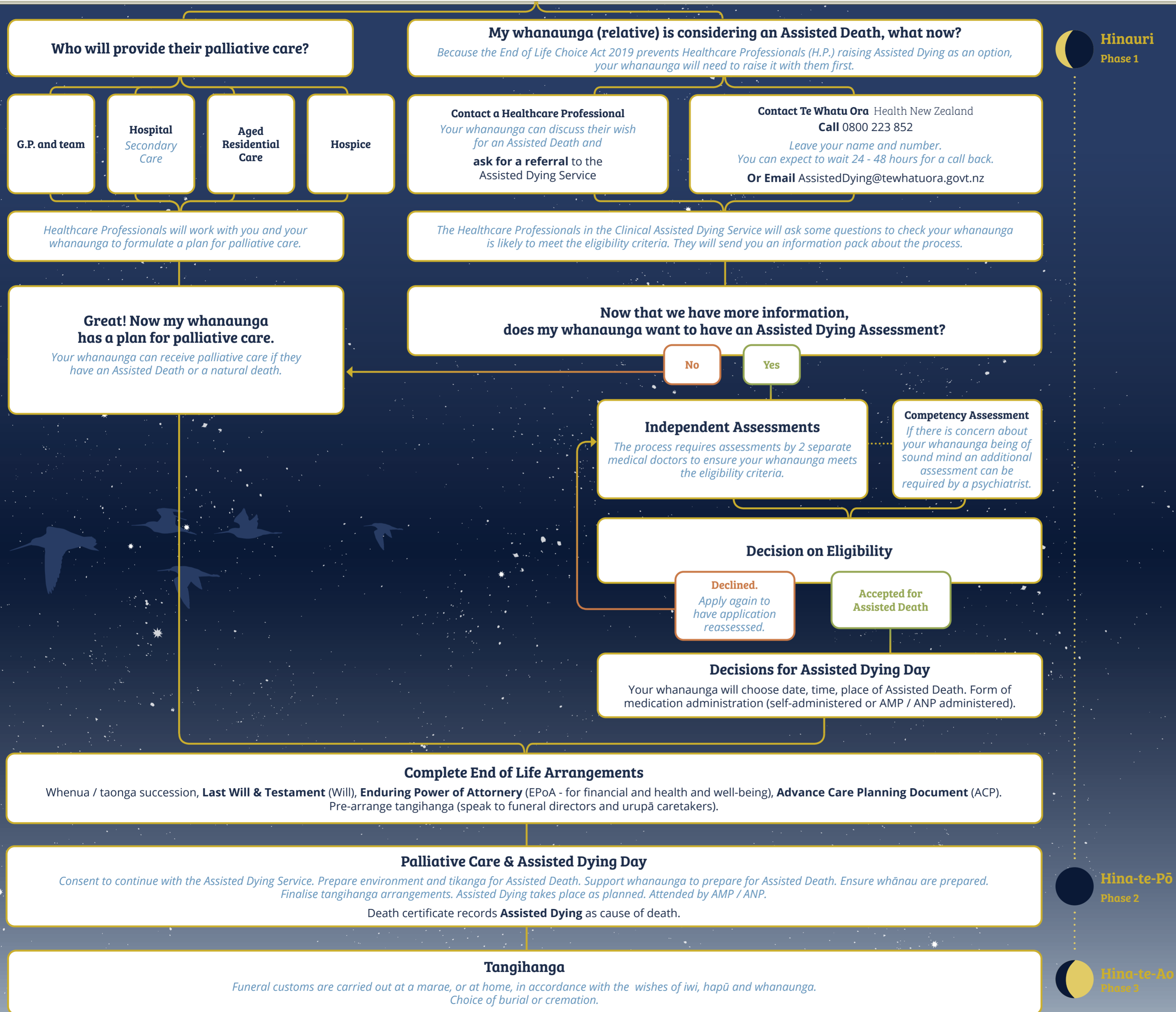


KAITIAKITANGA ASSISTED DYING PATHWAY FLOWCHART

ROLES OF VARIOUS MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS in the Assisted Dying Process

AMP

Attending Medical Practitioner
 The medical practitioner who provides end-to-end care throughout the Assisted Dying (AD) service, including carrying out the first eligibility assessment and preparing and administering the medication for AD.

ANP

Attending Nurse Practitioner
 The nurse practitioner may be involved in the AD process and administer the AD medication (acting under the instruction of the AMP).

IMP

Independent Medical Practitioner
 The medical practitioner provides the second eligibility assessment in the AD process.

Psychiatrist

A medical practitioner with a speciality in psychiatry who is registered with the medical Council in the psychiatry scope and holds an Annual Practising Certificate. A psychiatrist may be required to perform a competency assessment as part of the AD process.

SCENZ

The SCENZ Group is a statutory body established to support the assisted dying service in New Zealand. It maintains lists of doctors, nurse practitioners, and psychiatrists who provide assisted dying services, and can connect you with a practitioner if your own doctor does not provide the service.
